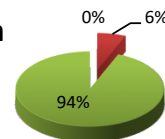

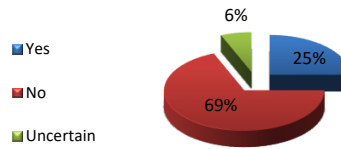

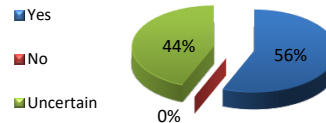
1. Was PIU your first choice for college?

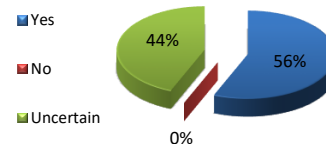
2. Do you think PIU alumni are effectively applying what they learn in communities?

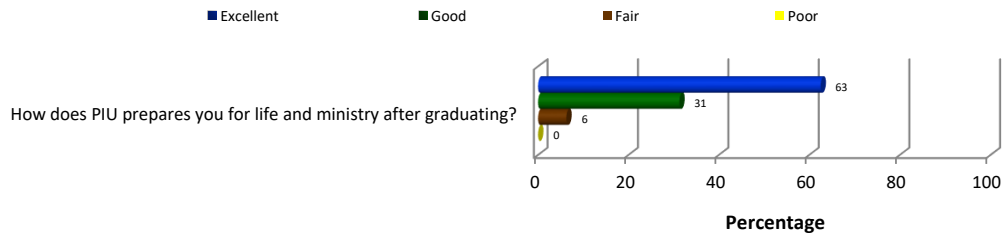
3. Do you think PIU alumni set good examples with their Christian lives?

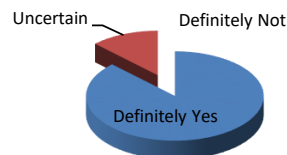
4. How does PIU prepares you for life and ministry after graduating?

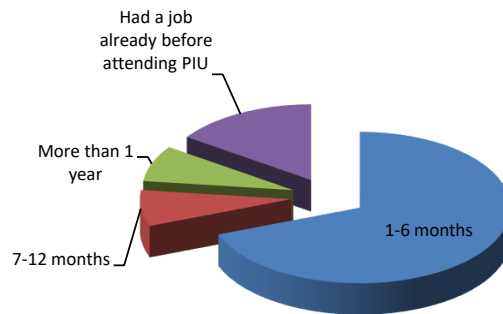

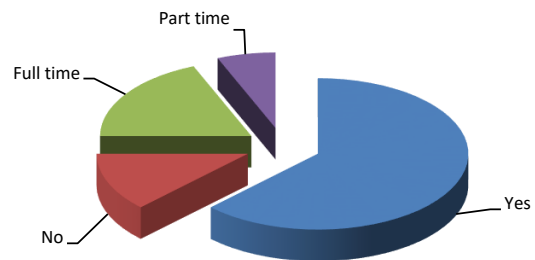

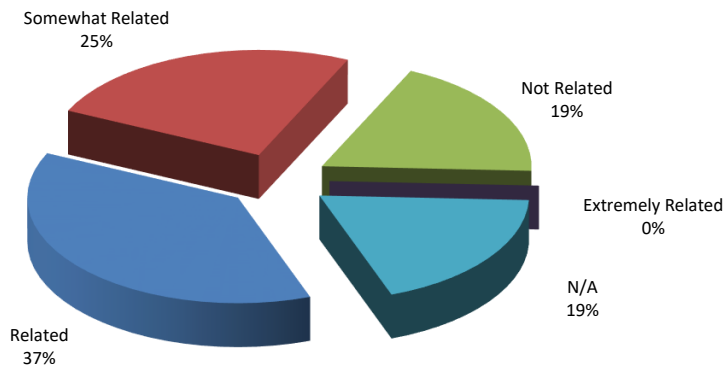


3. If you are employed, how do you rate you job relevance to your field of study at PIU?

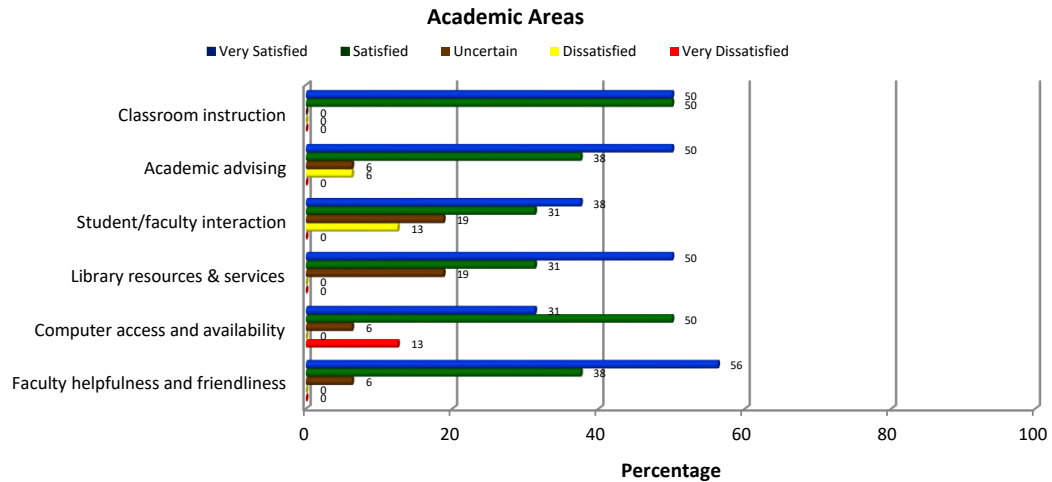


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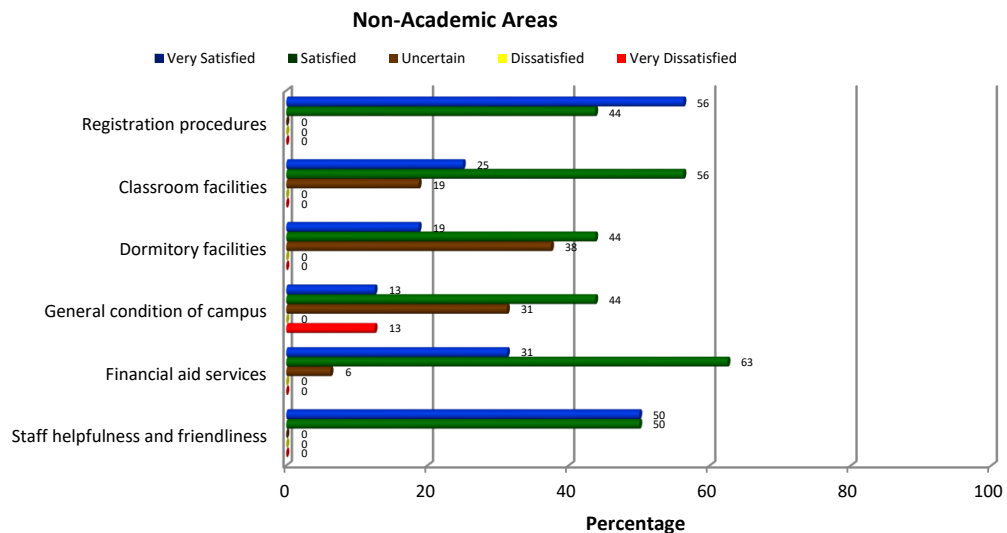

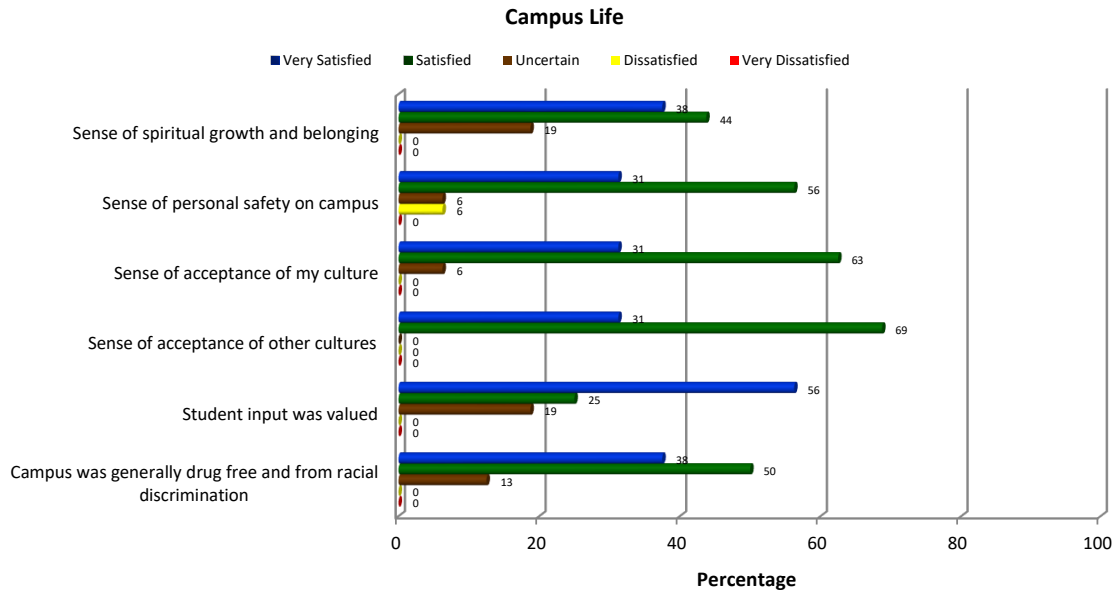
